

## Abstract submission guidelines

### Submission

An email with the cover note information and the attached abstract must be sent to [jade.redfern@canberra.edu.au](mailto:jade.redfern@canberra.edu.au) by 5pm AEST on the 31<sup>st</sup> of October 2015.

You will receive confirmation of receipt of the abstract within 48 hours. You will be notified if your abstract has been accepted no later than the 6<sup>th</sup> of November 2015.

### Cover note

The email accompanying the abstract must contain the following information

1. The presenter's full name
2. The presenter's institutional affiliation
3. The current position held by the presenter
4. If the abstract is to be considered for an oral presentation, poster presentation or both
5. The first and second most relevant meeting topics that your abstract aligns with

### Meeting topics

The meeting will be divided into the following topics. Please indicate the most appropriate topics for your presentation when submitting your abstract.

1. Vaccines
2. Antiviral therapies
3. Viral immunology
4. Cellular interactions
5. Clinical virology and epidemiology

### Abstract format requirements

Abstract must be a word file with a .doc or .docx file format and attached to the cover note email.

Abstracts must follow the following format

**Title:** Centred, font – Arial 16pt bold. Maximum 30 words.

**Authors:** Centred, font – Arial 10pt italics

**Body :** Justified, Font; Arial 12pt normal. Maximum 400 words.

The body should further be broken down into Introduction, Methods, Results and Conclusion.
